The Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly is a concrete output of the process that started with the 1992 Rio Earth Summit and paved the way for democratic participation for a sustainable future known as "Local Agenda 21" in Turkey. All of the mechanisms that ensure the empowerment of young people living in Ankara between the ages of 15-30, who develop themselves and their city, and produce solutions to existing problems through local participation, have taken the form of the Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly. The Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly was established to rejuvenate the city administration and determine youth policies by the youth, without any tendency to politicize, which allows all youth in Ankara to have differences such as religion, language, ideology and political identity with their specific weight in their own pot with its supra-political position. No decision-making mechanism was a pioneer in its establishment. It is a youth association that covers all young segments of Ankara due to the common mind efforts between the Ankara City Council and the young people in line with the demands of the youth.

The Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly adopts the creation of the tools for active participation of young people in life by young people as a fundamental principle. Policies developed for the activation of which tools while enabling the participation of young people are thought to be effective in terms of the functioning of democratic participation processes.

MISSION



GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The young people who came together around the youth work group in the first place, carried out regular activities for about a year and a half, and started the construction process as a platform open to all young people between the ages of 15-30 living in Ankara. During the 18-month period, which started as a youth working group, studies were carried out to institutionalize the common mind approach with the adoption of the city council philosophy by the youth. All young people were invited to participate, 20 days before the general assembly date, in the press of Ankara Metropolitan Municipality, in the announcement portals of the City Council, and in the social media and network groups of the youth working group.

On January 30, 2022, at 11:00, the Youth Assembly General Assembly was held at the Ankara Chamber of Commerce Assembly Hall with an enthusiastic crowd of more than 1000 attendee by 600 delegates and as many guests. Ankara Metropolitan Mayor Mansur Yavaş, as well as the heads of departments of the metropolitan municipality, attended the general assembly. Ankara City Council President Halil İbrahim Yılmaz, Vice President Prof. Dr. Savaş Zafer Şahin and the members of the executive committee, there was also intense participation from the assembly and working groups within the Ankara City Council. In the General Assembly, the youth council president and 34 executive board members were elected and the youth council was established.



PANDEMIC AND YOUTH FORUM

The COVID-19 epidemic, which affected the entire world. threatened people's health and caused deaths as well as their social life. It has caused damage to the social factors that ensure the continuity of social life. One of the disadvantaged groups affected by the crisis is the young population. We have planned to hold a "Pandemic and Youth" meeting to evaluate the damages and ensure the continuity of social life.





With this meeting, we aimed to reveal a will to form the basis of action plans in addition to the current situation assessment in the fields of education, health, civil society, employment, sociology and psychology in terms of sociological needs and action analysis.

In addition to ensuring the participation of the working groups within the Ankara Citizen's Assembly, it was planned to invite experts in their fields to the meeting. We have considered arranging the invitation of the working groups through the city council and other experts as the youth assembly working group. In addition, members from the ten parliament from diverse working groups participated.

1-2 JUNE YOUTH WORKSHOP 13 JULY YOUTH MEETING

Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly designed a workshop to identify the problems that concern the youth in Ankara and to find solutions of dimensions of youth problems. diverse Youth participation was encouraged in order to realize citizen participation, which is emphasised by the United Nations Sustainability Goals. The implementation of the principles put forth by the Council of Europe regarding the promotion of youth policies in youth policies in the local area of Ankara constitutes the most crucial reason for our work. The primary motivation of the Youth Workshop was to ensure the active participation of the youth living in Ankara in youth policies, to establish youth awareness, to identify and solve the problems that the youth people in Ankara today are suffering from, with the perspective of the youth.

















Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly organizes orientation meetings at regular intervals. These orientation meetings mainly aim to introduce youth solidarity, civil society awareness and "youth assembly" logic to young people living in Ankara. On the other hand, orientation activities enable the newly joined youth parliament members to be more active in the youth council, aiming to maximize the prejudices of the youth against each other in any way. It organizes meet-up games and free podium activities in order to increase the awareness of the young people respecting differences, sensitive to disadvantages, protecting their city, and solidarity. Orientation meetings are held with the registration of every 50 new members and are reserved for the first 6 months of the youth assembly.

Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly hosted a wide range of speakers from the defence industry to the public, from education to entrepreneurship, at the summit, in which the AISEC association also participated, highlighted gender inequality in the business world and pioneered the creation of a platform where ideas that could offer advice to young people on employment could come to light.

ANKARA MANUAL FROM A TO Z


















A'DAN Z'YE ANKARA SECOND EDITION


"SÖZ MECLİSTEN İÇERİDE": PRESENT COMPANY INCLUDED

Several academicians and youth people came together to discuss sustainable and adaptable urban planning on the subject of "Empowerment of Youth in Urban Governance". In this panel, they emphasized the participation of young people and the empowerment of sustainable governance methods. The event highlighted the importance of youth involvement in urban management with a simulation of urban government.

What is "Bir Gençlik Vakası"?

"A case of Youth" is an event series that touches on every dimension of young people living in Ankara. "A Case of Youth" is a youth solidarity movement by the Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly. All university students in Ankara will come together within the framework of culture, art, academy and sports activities. In this context, the event will be held in all universities in Ankara. The event is organized entirely by volunteer students, and the Ankara Metropolitan Municipality undertakes financial support.

What do we aim?

Ankara is currently one of the youngest provinces of Turkey, with over 500 thousand university and high school students. Statistically, about twenty per cent of the total population of Ankara is young. However, there are spatial difficulties for young people to reach each other. All young people in the capital need a young mind that will shape the present and future of the young people of Ankara. As young people living in the capital, this series of events has been put forward in order to determine our youth policies together and to carry out our arts, culture, academy and sports activities together. To sum up, the Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly started this project in order to build the title of Youth Friendly Capital together.

Within this meeting, members of the Assembly and international students received education in an atmosphere where different cultures are welcomed with tolerance.

The ECO-CLIMATE Summit/Fair, which was organized under the leadership of the Ankara Chamber of Commerce (ATO), was held on March 30-31 at the ATO Congressium. At the summit, where stakeholders from the private and public sectors and local governments were present, the climate crisis, its effects on various sectors and green cycling were discussed in various simultaneous sessions. Art and Culture WORKING GROUP

Definition

It is a working group that aims to contribute to society by connecting ideas and people and reflecting, stimulating and encouraging positive change. Scope

- To organise various excursions and informative tours to cultural heritage sites
- To facilitate the transportation of activities in the field of art for young people by establishing various new formations in the area of art

Data-science and Statistics working group

Definition

It is a working group aiming to analyse and make sense of the vast volumes and sources of data on social inequalities of youth people using social research techniques in the Ankara context.

Scope

High School WORKING GROUP

Definition

The high school working group is a solidarity and cooperation group of the youngest parts of the Ankara Youth Parliament aged between 15 to 18 before college education. It plays an active role in increasing the efficiency of the policies and the inclusiveness for 15 - 18 cohort groups in the decision-making process in urban planning.

Scope

- To ensure the activity of the Youth Parliament before college education
- To strengthen the social bonds of high school students
- To enable high school students to actively participate in urban planning
- To organise events for high school students learning, development and future planning






International Committee

BGM International Committee is a committee established in November 2022 to strengthen and represent Ankara youth in the international arena. Although the working logic is slightly different from the BGM Working Groups, the purpose they serve is common. So in short; The International Committee takes the necessary steps to empower youth in the International arena through Democratic and Participatory processes.

Previously, it carried out the European Youth Capital 2026 process, reported/followed nearly 40 International Organizations and contacted nearly 10 International Organizations. He still continues to work actively.





Solidarity and Disaster Working Group

Adopting the principle of empowering the youth in every field, the Capital Youth Assembly established the Disaster and Solidarity Working Group after the 6 February Kahramanmaraş-based disaster in the context of the youth empowering themselves and their environment in every field. Our Disaster and Solidarity WG members have received all necessary first aid and crisis management training in the event of a disaster and work in coordination with authorized search and rescue teams at the state level.





Rights Based Studies Committee

Capital Youth Assembly Rights-Based Studies Committee; It is a committee that is based on international human rights standards and aims to support and protect human rights in practice, working on a broad framework such as animal rights, environmental rights, and nature rights, as well as human rights and freedoms in the basic, social, economic and cultural fields. Disadvantaged women, men, children, animals, etc. He advances the process by writing projects for cutting and conducting workshops.





Persons who want to work in the relevant committee are expected to work within the framework of the principles of rights-based approach.

Local Youth Action Plan

On April 28, 2022, Local Youth Action Plan Announcement Program with ABB President Mansur Yavaş

Considering the political, sociological and economic crises and the pandemic, it is seen that the resistance of both national and local authorities to make social policies in the field of youth stands crucially weak and unsustainable overall the world. The recent instability in Turkey, on the other hand, has directly and indirectly affected Turkish society, particularly youth people in Turkey. In order to increase the resistance and sustainability, a policy document should be prepared by conducting a social needs analysis. Therefore, the necessity of creating emergency action plans becomes concrete for local, national and international context.



In this regard, the activities and events in the field of youth appear as a reflection of the public administration paradigms of the 1970s. To closely observe the changing paradigms in the changing world, especially the dynamics of the young population, decision-makers should consider youth as a policy unit. In this context, creating the youth action plan of Ankara Metropolitan Municipality, which does not exist yet, has been determined as the aim of this work as Capital Youth Assembly of the Citizen's Assembly. In this study, Ankara's Local Youth Action Plan will be prepared by considering the essential dynamics of the strategy document.



In order to prepare a Local Youth Action Plan, it is necessary to analyse the current situation in the first place. Secondly, we need to examine the sociological needs of young people, then to prepare a policy document, and finally to prepare a youth action plan with the data and experiences obtained during the action plan investigations. Since preparing Ankara's Local Youth Action Plan requires a holistic approach, more than one stakeholder should be involved in the policy-writing process. We know the essential priorities for the Local Youth Action Plan at the micro, mezzo and macro levels.

The Capital Youth Assembly has added a new one to a series of activities that will ensure the empowerment of young people in the city and their participation in the city administration. By opening the doors of the Ankara Metropolitan Municipality Council, the highest decision-making body of the city, to the young people, it was possible to experience the place that transforms the wishes and demands of the youth into politics.
